Action Proposed: Award Construction Agreement

Description:

Nash County was awarded \$900,000 in grant funding from the North Carolina Department of Commerce Rural Economic Development Division. These funds are for Grant Administration, Public Facilities, and Public Services.

This project includes the following construction: installation of approximately 3,825 LF 5' sidewalk at Spring Hope and Castalia Community Parks and the installation of 7 handwashing stations at various locations in Nash County. This is the final element of the CDBG-CV grant.

The pre-bid meeting for the project on January 15, 2026. Bids were opened for this project on January 22, 2026. There were 5 total bids opened and certified on the attached bid tabulation. The Wooten Company recommends that Nash County accept the bid of the lowest bidder, Bridgeview Contracts Inc., with a base bid of \$280,780.

Recommendation: Award the Construction Agreement for CDBG-CV, subject to review and approval by the County Manager and County Attorney.



AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is by and between Nash County (Owner) and Bridgeview Contractors, Inc. (Contractor).

Terms used in this Agreement have the meanings stated in the General Conditions and the Supplementary Conditions.

Owner and Contractor hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1 - WORK

1.01 Contractor shall complete all Work as specified or indicated in the Contract Documents. The Work is generally described as follows:

- A. Installation of approximately 3825 LF of sidewalk and 70 LF 30" retaining wall at Spring Hope and Castalia Community Parks.
- B. Installation of seven (7) handwashing stations in various locations in Nash County.

ARTICLE 2 - PROJECT

2.01 The Project for which the Work under the Contract Documents may be the whole or only a part is generally described as follows:

FY 2020 CDBG Coronavirus - Handwashing and Trails Improvements Handwashing Stations and Sidewalk/Trail Improvement Project at the following locations:

174 JW Glover Memorial Park (Nashville, NC) (Handwashing Station)

118 West Railroad Street (Town Hall) Spring Hope, NC (Handwashing Station)

211 McLean Street (Community Park) Spring Hope, NC (Handwashing Station (2) and Trail)

9656 Main Street (Castalia Community Park) Castalia, NC (Handwashing Station and Trail)

302 NW Railroad Street (Whitakers, Town Park) Whitakers, NC (Service Tap and Handwashing Station (2))

ARTICLE 3 - ENGINEER

3.01 The Owner has retained The Wooten Company ("Engineer") to act as Owner's representative, assume all duties and responsibilities of Engineer, and have the rights and authority assigned to Engineer in the Contract.

3.02 The part of the Project that pertains to the Work has been designed by The Wooten Company.

ARTICLE 4 - CONTRACT TIMES

4.01 *Time of the Essence*

- A. All time limits for Milestones, if any, Substantial Completion, and completion and readiness for final payment as stated in the Contract Documents are of the essence of the Contract.

4.02 *Contract Times: Days*

- A. The Work will be substantially completed within 58 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run as provided in Paragraph 4.01 of the General Conditions, and completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions within 0 days days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run.

4.03 *Liquidated Damages*

- A. Contractor and Owner recognize that time is of the essence as stated in Paragraph 4.01 above and that Owner will suffer financial and other losses if the Work is not completed and Milestones not achieved within the Contract Times, as duly modified. The parties also recognize the delays, expense, and difficulties involved in proving, in a legal or arbitration proceeding, the actual loss suffered by Owner if the Work is not completed on time. Accordingly, instead of requiring any such proof, Owner and Contractor agree that as liquidated damages for delay (but not as a penalty):
 1. *Final Completion*: Contractor shall pay Owner \$500 for each day that expires after the time (as duly adjusted pursuant to the Contract) specified above for Substantial Completion, until the Work is substantially complete.
 2. Liquidated damages for failing to timely attain final completion could overlap and therefore be additive.
- B. If Owner recovers liquidated damages for a delay in completion by Contractor, then such liquidated damages are Owner's sole and exclusive remedy for such delay, and Owner is precluded from recovering any other damages, whether actual, direct, excess, or consequential, for such delay, except for special damages (if any) specified in this Agreement.

ARTICLE 5---CONTRACT PRICE

- 5.01 Owner shall pay Contractor for completion of the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents, the amounts that follow, subject to adjustment under the Contract:
 - A. For all Work for the Lump Sum of \$280,480.00.

ARTICLE 6--PAYMENT PROCEDURES

6.01 *Submittal and Processing of Payments*

- A. Contractor shall submit Applications for Payment in accordance with Article 15 of the General Conditions. Applications for Payment will be processed by Engineer as provided in the General Conditions..

6.02 *Progress Payments; Retainage*

- A. Owner shall make progress payments on the basis of Contractor's Applications for Payment on or about the 25th day of each month during performance of the Work as provided in Paragraph 6.02.A.1 below, provided that such Applications for Payment have been submitted in a timely manner and otherwise meet the requirements of the Contract. All such payments will be measured by the Schedule of Values established as provided in the General Conditions

(and in the case of Unit Price Work based on the number of units completed) or, in the event there is no Schedule of Values, as provided elsewhere in the Contract.

1. Prior to Substantial Completion, progress payments will be made in an amount equal to the percentage indicated below but, in each case, less the aggregate of payments previously made and less such amounts as Owner may withhold, including but not limited to liquidated damages, in accordance with the Contract
 - a. 95 percent of the value of the Work completed (with the balance being retainage) in accordance with NC GS 143-141.1(b1)(1).
 - 1) If 50 percent or more of the Work has been completed, as determined by Engineer, and if the character and progress of the Work have been satisfactory to Owner and Engineer, then as long as the character and progress of the Work remain satisfactory to Owner and Engineer, there will be no additional retainage in accordance with NC GS 143-141.1(b1)(2); and
 - b. 95 percent of cost of materials and equipment not incorporated in the Work (with the balance being retainage).
- B. Upon Substantial Completion of the entire construction to be provided under the construction Contract Documents, Owner shall pay an amount sufficient to increase total payments to Contractor to 100 percent of the Work completed, less such amounts set off by Owner pursuant to Paragraph 15.01.E of the General Conditions, and less 200 percent of Engineer's estimate of the value of Work to be completed or corrected as shown on the punch list of items to be completed or corrected prior to final payment.

6.03 *Final Payment*

- A. Upon final completion and acceptance of the Work, Owner shall pay the remainder of the Contract Price in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions.

6.04 *Consent of Surety*

- A. Owner will not make final payment, or return or release retainage at Substantial Completion or any other time, unless Contractor submits written consent of the surety to such payment, return, or release.

6.05 *Interest*

- A. Once a Progress or Final Payment Application has been submitted by the contractor, recommended by the Engineer, and Approved by the Owner, if payment is not made, the Contractor will be due interest beginning on the 46th day following Owner acceptance at a rate of 1 percent (1%) per month or fraction thereof in accordance with NC General Statute 143-134.1(a).

- B. The documents listed in paragraph 7.01.A are attached to this Agreement (except as expressly noted otherwise above).
- C. There are no Contract Documents other than those listed above in this Article 7.
- D. The Contract Documents may only be amended, modified or supplemented as provided in Contract.

ARTICLE 8---REPRESENTATIONS, CERTIFICATIONS, AND STIPULATIONS

8.01 *Contractor's Representations*

- A. In order to induce Owner to enter into Agreement, Contractor makes the following representations:
 - 1. Contractor has examined and carefully studied the Contract Documents, including Addenda.
 - 2. Contractor has visited the Site, conducted a thorough visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
 - 3. Contractor is familiar with all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
 - 4. Contractor has carefully studied the reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and the drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to the Technical Data in such reports and drawings.

5. Contractor has carefully studied the reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
6. Contractor has considered the information known to Contractor itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Contract Documents; and the Technical Data identified in the Supplementary Conditions or by definition, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and Technical Data on (a) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (b) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Contractor; and (c) Contractor's safety precautions and programs.
7. Based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, Contractor agrees that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the performance of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Times, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract.
8. Contractor is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Contract Documents.
9. Contractor has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Contractor has discovered in the Contract Documents, and of discrepancies between Site conditions and the Contract Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Contractor.
10. The Contract Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance and furnishing of the Work.
11. Contractor's entry into this Contract constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Contractor that without exception all prices in the Agreement are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Contract Documents.

8.02 *Contractor's Certifications*

- A. Contractor certifies that it has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for or in executing the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 8.02:
 1. "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process or in the Contract execution;
 2. "fraudulent practice" means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process or the execution of the Contract to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish Bid or Contract prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
 3. "collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish Bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and

4. “coercive practice” means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.

8.03 *Standard General Conditions*

- A. Owner stipulates that if the General Conditions that are made a part of this Contract are EJCDC® C-700, Standard General Conditions for the Construction Contract (2018), published by the Engineers Joint Contract Documents Committee, and if Owner is the party that has furnished said General Conditions, then Owner has plainly shown all modifications to the standard wording of such published document to the Contractor, through a process such as highlighting or “track changes” (redline/strikeout), or in the Supplementary Conditions.

1. **One Instrument; Conflict.** This Addendum and the Agreement to which this Addendum is attached shall be deemed one instrument. All capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the same meanings as are ascribed to such terms in the Agreement. If the terms of this Addendum conflict with the terms of the Agreement, the terms of this Addendum shall control.
2. **Insurance.** The Undersigned shall, at all times during the term of the Agreement, provide and maintain in force commercial general liability insurance covering bodily injury (including death) and property damage (including contractual liability covering the Undersigned’s indemnity obligations) under a policy or policies providing combined single limit coverage of not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for each occurrence with Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) coverage on an annual aggregate basis, together with worker’s compensation and employer’s liability insurance in such amounts as shall be required by law from time to time. All such insurance shall contain an endorsement naming Nash County as additional insured. The Undersigned agrees that its insurance shall be primary with respect to any claim arising from or related to the performance or non-performance by the Undersigned of its obligations under the terms of the Agreement. The Undersigned shall deliver to Nash County a Certificate from an insurance company licensed to do business in the State of North Carolina evidencing the required insurance coverage, which Certificate shall state that such insurance coverage may not be materially changed or cancelled without at least thirty (30) days prior written notice by certified mail to Nash County.
3. **Indemnity.** The Undersigned shall defend and indemnify Nash County against and hold Nash County harmless from all claims, losses, liabilities, damages and expenses (including attorneys’ fees) asserted against or incurred by Nash County (a) arising from or related to any breach of the Agreement by the Undersigned, (b) any injury to or death of any person arising from or related to negligent acts or omissions or wrongful misconduct of the Undersigned or the Undersigned’s agents, employees and contractors, and (c) loss of or damage to any property arising from or related to negligent acts or omissions or wrongful misconduct of the Undersigned or the Undersigned’s agents, employees and contractors.
4. **Governing Law and Consent to Jurisdiction.** The Agreement shall be construed and enforced with the laws of the State of North Carolina notwithstanding its conflict of law principles. The Undersigned agrees that any legal action or proceeding arising out of or relating to the Agreement shall be instituted in the Superior Court of Nash County, North Carolina. The Undersigned consents to the jurisdiction of such court and waives any objection relating to the basis for personal or in rem jurisdiction or to venue.
5. **E-Verify Certification.** Employers and their subcontractors with twenty-five (25) or more employees in the State of North Carolina as defined in Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes must comply with E-Verify requirements in order to contract with governmental units. E-Verify is a program operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security and other federal agencies, or any successor or equivalent program used to verify the work authorization of newly hired employees. The Undersigned certifies that it is aware of and in compliance with the requirements of E-Verify and Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes. In addition, the Undersigned certifies that to the best of its knowledge, any subcontractors employed by it as a part of this Agreement are in compliance with the requirements of E-Verify and Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes. The Undersigned acknowledges and agrees that local governments are prohibited from contracting with persons

or entities that do not comply with E-Verify requirements and that Nash County is relying on the certifications set forth herein in order to contract with the Undersigned.

6. Iran Divestment Act Certification.
