


# GET IT RIGHT AT THE SITE

## KEEP THESE ITEMS OUT OF THE RECYCLING BIN!



- ⊗ Aerosol cans
- ⊗ All batteries (car, lithium, etc.)
- ⊗ Ceramic items
- ⊗ Clothing or textiles
- ⊗ Diapers
- ⊗ Disposable cups (plastic and paper)
- ⊗ Electronics
- ⊗ Food-tainted items
- ⊗ Hazardous waste
- ⊗ Household glass
- ⊗ Medical waste
- ⊗ Plastic bags/wrap
- ⊗ Scrap metal/wood
- ⊗ Shredded paper
- ⊗ Styrofoam/peanuts
- ⊗ Tangles (cords, hoses, wires, etc.)
- ⊗ Tires
- ⊗ Toys

## ALSO ACCEPTED

The following items are also accepted at all convenience sites unless indicated otherwise. Please see the site attendant for questions and other restrictions.

-  Antifreeze (*site 7 only*)
-  Clothing, shoes, books and vacuum cleaners
-  Bulky items - couch, mattress, table, chairs, furniture, etc.
-  Yard waste - small limbs and clippings only (200 lbs max)
-  Fluorescent light bulbs and thermostat mercury switches
-  White goods and all appliances, (*if contains FREON, take to landfill*)
-  Electronics - computers, cellphones, TVs, etc. (Don't cut cords or take backs off)
-  Used batteries, used motor oil and oil filters. (*all except site 4*)
-  Tires (*site 1 and 7 only*)
-  Wooden pallets, construction and demolition. No commercial contractors. (*site 7 only*)
-  Bagged household waste

## NOT ACCEPTED

- Agricultural waste
- Liquid & hazardous waste
- Industrial, institutional and municipal waste
- Radioactive waste
- Yard waste and construction and demolition materials over 200 lbs.
- Burning or smoldering materials
- Bricks, large stumps, logs, concrete, shingles, animal carcasses, animal waste or auto parts.
