

## Recess Meeting March 10, 2021

A recess meeting of the Nash County Board of Commissioners was held at 1:30 PM, March 10, 2021 in the Frederick B. Cooper, Jr. Commissioners' Room at the Claude Mayo, Jr. Administration Building in Nashville, NC.

Present were Chairman Robbie B. Davis and Commissioners Marvin C. Arrington, Fred Belfield, Jr., Dan Cone, Sue Leggett, J. Wayne Outlaw, and Mary P. Wells.

Others present were Stacie Shatzer, Donna Wood, Janice Evans, Zee B. Lamb, Vince Durham, Battle, Winslow, Scott & Wiley and other staff members and members of the public.

Chairman Davis called the meeting to order and provided a brief explanation regarding prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance in Nash County. He stated it is customary that Nash County starts each meeting with a prayer by a Commissioner and Pledge of Allegiance and that anyone wishing to participate in the prayer, moment of silence, or a prayer of their own choice was welcomed.

Chairman Davis called on Mr. Fred Belfield, Jr. for the invocation and Mr. J. Wayne Outlaw to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Davis presented for the Board's consideration a request by the Nash County Public Schools Board of Education asking the Nash County Board of Commissioners to support action taken by the Board of Education to award a steel contract early due to the rising cost of steel for the new Red Oak Elementary School Project. He advised the School Board awarded the steel package at a cost of approximately \$1.2 million to H.G. Reynolds Co., subject to the Board of Commissioners agreeing to cover the cost incurred to date should the county not secure the financing for the new school project.

On motion of Mary P. Wells seconded by J. Wayne Outlaw and duly passed with Fred Belfield, Jr. voting "no" that the Nash County Board of Commissioners will be responsible for the engineering fees incurred up to date and up to a maximum of 4% of the steel cost and a maximum amount not to exceed \$44,000 due to the Nash County

Public Schools Board of Education awarding an early package for steel for the new Red Oak Elementary School Project.

On motion of Sue Leggett seconded by Dan Cone and duly passed that the meeting recess until Tuesday, March 30, 2021 at 9:00 AM 2021 in the Frederick B. Cooper, Jr. Commissioners' Room at the Claude Mayo, Jr. Administration Building in Nashville, NC for a budget work session.
